ukulele and mandolin.



VALE PAUL BONNER JONES:

The country music fraternity is mourning the loss of Aussie Iarrikin, a "troubadour" and accomplished singer songwriter Paul Bonner Jones. PBJ or Jonesy to his friends will be fondly remembered for his friendship, swag of songs and memories by loved ones here and as far as Nashville. "I thought the world of PBJ," best buddy Jason Wilburn (Surefire publisher, Nashville) wrote in his tribute.

"It feels so much quieter without his voice and guitar, and his spirit will live on in the countless stories and songs he left behind."

Paul assisted the grass-roots Nashville Songwriters Festival voluntarily with sound, signwriting and performances on the Surefire stage from 2007 - 2012. He also assisted at TSA showcases, workshops and the popular talent quest with sound, host and performances.

"He was a huge part of our little group, and the love, laughter and music he shared will be remembered forever," Jason said. "I can't believe he's gone."

Tootsies artist John Stone was also shocked by the passing of this Aussie friend on October 29.


"Jonesy was the first one who brought me to Tamworth the first time," John wrote. "We have remained friends ever since and my heart goes out to the entire family."

During 2023-24, Paul worked tirelessly restoring the Dolphin 1919, a heritage listed 'gentleman's launch', once owned by Peter Allen. The Gold Coast-Woolomin father of six Paul spent over 12 months at the QLD Maritime Museum Brisbane giving the old boat a new lease of life. Paul experienced many highs in his singing career spanning over 30 years.



It began when he had a coach painter apprenticeship at Eveleigh carriage works, Sydney. There, he was taught how to play guitar by the old mentors. Gigs started in the early 80s with his Charged Up duo (guitarist Glenn Stead), playing pubs and clubs all around Sydney, central coast, Snowy Mountains and led him to a wedding near Brisbane - Gold Coast.

Jonesy jam nites took off in Coolangatta in the early 90s which lasted for over 15 years, He held a residency at the Hard Rock café, Surfers Paradise & support act for comedian Phyllis Diller. The Rolling Stones wrote a double page feature on him. He travelled to Nashville (2007-2012) where he met Surefire's publisher Jason Wilburn on Music Row and made a life-long friend. In 2009 Jason's mother Arvemia invited Paul for a private interview with legendary songstress Loretta Lynn at her Hurricane Hills ranch.



During his stay, he created an Australian Songwriters Showcase (2010-2012) providing an opportunity for Aussies to perform on Music Row and at the Capital Theatre Tamworth (2010-2012). Fanny Lumsden performed at her first Tamworth on that stage.

Paul has picked up a few songwriting awards - North Coast Dolphin Awards (country and folk) and South Pacific International Songwriters festival (folk and country) in the mid 90s and numerous TSA top 5 finalists.

He has facilitated several songwriters workshops for TSA, and other workshops in Dubbo, Longreach, Gold Coast and Norfolk Island. He


has taught music and songwriting for the Australian Children's Music Foundation in Dubbo (2011) and Wacol, Brisbane (2012-13). He coproduced a disabilities album for Westhaven Dubbo (2011); a first for NSW and recorded songs with Norfolk primary children (2012) and Miami State School (2019, 2022).

Paul was a proud 6th Generation First Fleeter able seaman Owen Cavanough, free settler, boat builder-repairer by trade and Irish by birth. Paul is being interred at Ebenezer near Windsor with a Memorial held on Australia Day! It was a fitting send-off for this proud Aussie singer songwriter. RIP PBJ.

MERILYN STEELE

Sydney-based artist Merilyn Steele has lived her songs, forging her own path over the past 30 years. "Against all the odds," she laughed. Two decades has passed since she released her first full album with several singles in between and an EP. It's been quite a journey from her school days when she started developing an interest in music. "My dad bought me a guitar for Christmas when I was 12," she recalled. A few guitar lessons, talent quests, studying music, her first song written at 14 and "it continued from there".

After school she entered the workforce in the corporate world and met her partner (the late Michael Gray) in her late 20s who was influential with their shared love of country music. Together, they travelled to the Tamworth CM festival 16 times, across the country to various festivals and she has been performing gigs ever since. Michael's unexpected passing three years ago turned Merilyn's life upside down and she dealt with the emotions associated with loss and grief. "What came out of it was, 'It hasn't happened to you. You are here so keep on living'," she said.

Her latest full album (no. 4) released in 2024 titled 'Making Memories' encompasses lessons from her life experiences. "Overall, it's an upbeat album about what has been dealt in life and I'm still here," she said. "Creating new memories with people who are on the journey."

The title song is about living life to the fullest; an upbeat positive song with a summery vibe. There's another dedicated to her ageing dog (12yo Gizmo), 'My White Shadow'. Another is a tribute to the late Glen Hannah who did her artwork on a previous album and sadly passed away in 2019. The final fun cheeky track 'Position Vacant' in search of a potential love interest after the loss of her partner of 26 years. "I always try to put a positive spin on things," she laughed.

Four songs from the album were nominated as semi-finalists in the 2024 Tamworth Songwriters Association awards; 'If I Could', 'Kinder (Be The Love)', 'Diamonds and Dust', 'Days Like This' Released on April 5, 2024 with all music and lyrics by Merilyn and produced, mixed and mastered by Michael Carpenter @the House Studio Sydney. A multi-instrumentalist, Merilyn recorded lead vocals, acoustic & electric rhythm guitars, mandolin, and harmony vocals. Michael was no slouch playing the drums, bass, keyboards/piano, electric lead & other guitar parts, harmony vocals.
